



## **2010 SAGE Singapore National Winners**

### **Champion - Saint Andrew's Junior College**

The team from Saint Andrew's Junior College, comprising Tran Le Bao Phuong, Ly Vivath, Phou Yanvey and Nguyen Hanh Trang also did Singapore proud by coming in 2nd runner-up for the Arthur Boschee and Evelyn Ball International Award for Social Enterprise, and winning the Institute for the Development of Entrepreneurial Activity (IDEA) Integrity Award and prize money of USD\$1000 from other awards. The team introduced vermi-composting to DomreiSar Village, Cambodia, by using blue worms to decompose rotten vegetables, which are commonly discarded as waste, into organic fertilizers that are then sold to villagers. In the process, they better the lives of the women by involving them in the packaging of fertilisers and providing them with an additional source of income. Part of the profits from the business is given to DomreiSar Junior High school as bursaries and scholarship for the poorer students.

### **1st Runner-up - Raffles Institution Junior College**

The team from Raffles Junior College, comprising Du Xuan, Moses Soh and Daphne Tay, beat 22 other teams from 15 countries to clinch the SAGE World Cup championship title and won prize money of USD\$750 from other awards. By providing equipment and training, the team enabled battered women in Nepal who are abused by their husbands, to set up their own home-based paper-producing outfits. Their enterprise helped the women to be financially independent and promoted gender equality.
